

STAR SPANGLED CELEBRATION CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

Setup will open at Noon on Wednesday, the week of the concert. Campers will be provided with a garbage bag and local information at the time of check-in. **Takedown *MUST* be completed by Sunday at 12:00 noon.** Please see that the garbage is disposed properly in the dumpster and recycling bins provided on the grounds. Many thanks for all the previous efforts. RV dumping is also available at the City Wastewater Treatment Plant on South Orange Street (Highway 14)

CAMPING PASSES AND VEHICLE INFORMATION:

A camping pass will be provided for you when entering the camping area. Please display the pass in your vehicle in plain site. Only those vehicles with a pass will be allowed in the campground. ***ONLY ONE VEHICLE PER CAMP SITE WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK IN THE CAMPING AREA.*** Speed limits of 5 MPH will be enforced at the campground.

PLEASE NOTE: There is only ***ONE tent/camper and ONE vehicle*** allowed per designated site. Visitors and/or extra vehicles may park in the campground parking lot outside of the gates.

VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE

GENERATORS: Quiet time after 12:00 midnight. As always, ***PLEASE*** be courteous to your neighbors. Please park your generator so as not to disturb your neighbors and if possible, try to provide some type of sound barricade.

CITY/PARK ORDINANCES:

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED IN THE ENTIRE PARK AREA. No food or beverage carry-ins are allowed in the concert area. No ATV's, fireworks, or weapons are allowed in the entire campground areas or at the festival areas. ***NO GROUND FIRES*** will be allowed at any time. We ask that you are very careful when grilling. Look for the ***"HOT COALS ONLY"*** barrels for disposing extinguished hot coals. Please do not use these barrels for trash.

PETS

Pets are ***not*** allowed at North Park campground, the festival grounds, or the concert area.

QUIET TIMES WITH LIGHTS OUT: 12:30 MIDNIGHT - 7:00 A.M.

Uniformed security will be on patrol in the campgrounds during quiet times. Loud parties WILL NOT be allowed at any time. Please respect your neighbors and see that your activities are not disruptive to others. Star Spangled Celebration Committee reserves the right to eject anyone that is disruptive to others, or their property, without refund. ***WE ENFORCE A NO TOLERANCE POLICY.***

Warm showers will be available at the swimming pool in Krouskop Park from the hours of 7-10 a.m. each morning. Shower tokens can be purchased for \$1.00 at the pool. Swim passes are also available at the pool during pool hours: Thurs and Fri: 10-12 noon, 1-5 pm, & 6-8:30 pm. Sat and Sun: 1-5 & 6-8:30 pm.

Please be clean and courteous when using the pool and shower facilities.
